




The subcutaneous injectable, or DMPA-SC, is a new type of contraceptive injectable administered under the skin. Unlike traditional injectables administered into the muscle (DMPA-IM), DMPA-SC combines drug and needle into one device (Uniject), making it easier for lower-level health workers to administer. PMA2020 began collecting data on the availability and use of subcutaneous injectables in 2015.





Source of Methods Among All Women Currently Using Injectables
